MINISTER'S INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT

To The Member and Adherents of Grand Bend and Greenway United Churches

Dear Fellow-Workers:

The Official Board in presenting this report of the past year's work, do so with great gratitude to Almighty God, for His guidance and blessing during 1928. In a year which has tested the generosity of the Church as a whole, it is encouraging to know that both our churches were able to pay all claims at home and abroad, with balances on hand. Especially gratifying is the fact that our charge is again on the Honour Roll of the Missionary and Maintenance fund of the Church. We trust that our people will aim to be as loyal as possible to this fund during this year, 1929.

In both churches, the Board of Stewards, after passing motions of appreciation to the Congregations for their loyalty, drew the attention of all the contributors to the necessity of each family paying to the treasurer of the church, one half of the yearly subscription by June 30th. It is hoped that all contributors will co-operate with the Stewards in their request.

During the year, the attendance at Church Schools and the Public Worship, has been well maintained with all the organizations holding meetings through the week, reporting a successful year. We commend our Ladies' Aids, W.M.S. and the Y.P.D. for their faithful work during the year. Our Young People's Departments report the largest budget in their history, with both societies contributing over \$108.00 each to the M. and M. Fund. Our choirs also are deserving of special mention, their faithful service of song each Sabbath being much appreciated. We closed the year 1928 with a report of 150 families, a total membership of 405 with the total amount raised for all purposes amounting to \$6823.00. In both churches the indebtedness on property is being steadily reduced, the mortgage on the new building at Grand Bend being reduced during the past year \$1400 while at Greenway, the building committee are hopeful that the entire cost of the new shed will be realized by next year.

We regret that a total of twenty highly esteemed persons were called away by the angel of death during the year, among these being the honoured name of Rev. Mr. Carriere, whose memory is a precious fragrance all over the Charge.

We face the future with confidence knowing that the Holy Spirit will continue to lead us into all truth. Let us dedicate ourselves afresh to the service of the King, and to the extension of His ever-widening kingdom. "The fields are white unto harvest." Let us gird on the armour and follow in the footsteps of Our Lord who will some day reward us for our faithfulness.
