MINISTER'S INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT

Dear Friends:

The Official Board, in sending forth this first report of the activities of our two Churches, Grand Bend, and Greenway, do so with great gratitude to Almighty God our Heavenly Father, for all the blessings, both temporal and spiritual, that have been ours in this our first year of Church Union. Harmonious and brotherly has been the spirit characterizing all our meetings, and we deeply realize after one year of actual Union, that we are truly united in heart and soul for the carrying on and the building up of the Master's kingdom.

The year closing on March 31st, 1927, shows progress all along the line. This report shows that our people have given generously. The Manse has been newly furnished, wired with hydro, and a new furnace installed. Both churches have taken the forward step in relation to building, Grand Bend a new church, and both Greenway and Grand Bend, new closed sheds.

It is impossible for us to deal with each report of the two churches, much as we would wish to. We commend the leaders of the different organizations and societies in each church for the zeal and enthusiasm with which they have carried on their work. Special mention should be made of the Sunday Schools, and the work amongst the young people. Both Sabbath Schools are well-staffed with faithful teachers, who from Sabbath to Sabbath instruct those entrusted to them, in the way of life. Last Winter, the young people in both churches held contests, which will long be remembered. The Church was made the rallying point for all activities, and much good we believe was accomplished.

The year upon which we have entered, commencing April 1st, 1927, and terminating December 31st, 1927, will be a nine months' year. It is expected that our yearly canvass will be made early in September. Besides our local expenses, we have the great claim of the church at large resting on us, otherwise known as the Maintenance and Extension Fund. This year our allotment is \$1650 for the twelve months, of \$1237.50 to be raised by the end of December. This amounts to \$618.75 for each Church. We are counting on each family to give generously to this cause, and thus show our loyalty to the whole church.

This report deals largely with finances. We regret that spiritual realities cannot be tabulated as easily as temporal matters. We have reason to believe as we glance back over the year, that much progress in the real verities of the Christian life has been made. The evidence is to be seen on every hand, that men and women are responding to the call of the Master. After all, friends, this is our real task, to bring men and women into a living fellowship with Jesus Christ. Let us this year bend every effort toward that goal. "He that winneth souls is wise." May we each say with Paul, "For me to live is Christ."

The Pastor deeply appreciates all the loyalty and kindness that has been shown to the Manse during the year.
