## *To the Members and Adherents of Grand Bend and Greenway Churches*

DEAR FRIENDS:—

With the publication of the first Annual Report of our Ministry together, I welcome the opportunity of sending "Greetings and Best Wishes for this New Year of 1935."

When you read this report (and I suggest that you peruse it carefully) I think you will share my opinion that 1934 was a successful year in the work of both congregations.

From a financial standpoint, it is very heartening. A marked increase is evident in the "Local Givings"—practically all our Church obligations were paid in full and arrears carried over from previous years were met.

In fact, the only discouraging feature was the decrease in the M. & M. offerings. Might we not say that this should be a challenge to us to give more attention to Missionary Givings this year. While paying our own way, let us not forget that there are Ministers and Missionaries in Northern Ontario, Western Canada and other lands who need our assistance if the Master's Great Commission "Go ye into all the world" is to be fulfilled. True our contributions may be small, but if reinforced by our thoughts and prayers, we will have the satisfaction of active participation in a Cause much greater than ourselves.

Unfortunately, a report of this nature is largely confined to dollars and cents; but let us look behind the statistics, and when we do we find evidence of spiritual progress in both our churches. Many of you have made sacrifices in money, time and energy in order to enhance the work of the church. To congratulate you is not really necessary for you know from experience that when you strive to serve God and your fellow men in a spiritual capacity, there comes to you a pulsating joy which far more than compensates your efforts.

Important as financial matters undoubtedly are, they should remain in a secondary position—for our primary need is a spiritual emphasis. Did not the Master say: "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things (money and other earthly needs) will be added unto you." In other words: "Put first things first."

Let us re-dedicate our lives afresh unto God as He has revealed Himself through Christ, and we shall be truly amazed at the wonderful way in which He will use us in making this a more Christian district in which to dwell.

Before closing, on behalf of Rev. Mr. Mathers and myself, I wish to thank you again for your kindly welcome, your continued interest and your excellent co-operation in the work of this Charge during the past year.
