MINISTER'S INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT

To The Members and Adherents of Grand Bend and Greenway United Churches

Dear Fellow-Workers:

The following pages give a "Bird's-eye view" of the financial standing of our two Churches for the nine month year commencing April 1st, and closing December 31st, 1927. It is a record that we may well take pride in. All the organizations in both Churches have enjoyed a prosperous year. It is gratifying to note, that every organization closed the year with a balance on hand. The Stewards are appreciative of the hearty response to their canvass both for the local Church and for the Maintenance and Extension fund. This year, by reason of the generous action of the congregations, the full allocation for the M. & E. fund was reached, and both treasurers closed their books with a balance. It is encouraging to see the increasing use in both Churches of the weekly duplex envelope, and where such are not being used, most contributors plan to give their contributions if possible monthly, and at least quarterly. In this way the treasurers are able to pay all salaries monthly, and to meet all expenses as they accrue. The year upon which we have entered will be a full calendar year of twelve months. We believe there will be general satisfaction with this change in Church years. Our annual canvass will be made, in all probability, in the month of June.

A fruitful series of special services was held at Greenway Church during the month of November. A passion for personal consecration and a quickened desire to see the establishment of righteousness in all the relationships of life were, we believe, the fruits of these efforts. At the opening service of the new Church building at Grand Bend, in response to a special appeal made by the minister and session, 36 persons joined the Church, four by transfer, and thirty-two on profession of faith. We closed the year with a total membership in both Churches of 410, an increase over last year of 37.

The nine months have also been characterized by a busy building program, with two new closed sheds, and the new Church at Grand Bend. It has thus been a memorable year. As a result of this building program, the Pastor's pastoral work has been more or less broken into, but he has attempted to carry out the intimation of the Official Board at its first meeting, to call at every home at least once a year, and to pay special attention to those seriously sick and shut-in. The consideration which has been shown by all the families in such a busy year is appreciated.

Despite our advances and successes, let us not look backward but forward. The future beckons with an appeal that cannot be resisted. The voice of the Great Teacher reaches every heart asking us for the consecration of the whole life to His service. Let us respond in the words of the great prophet Isaiah—"Here am I, Oh Lord, send me." Loyal to God and to His Church, let us move on into the future, to deepen our fellowship together in Jesus Christ our Saviour.
